

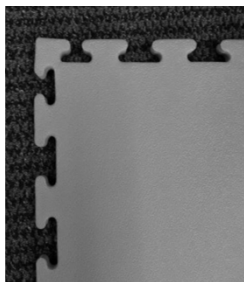


Installing Your Zebra Puzzle Mats

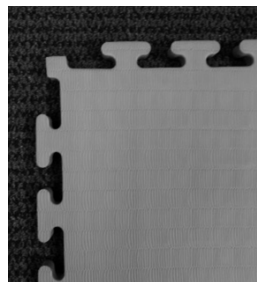
For optimal performance and longevity, it is important to install your Zebra puzzle mats properly. Please read through all of these instructions regarding the installation of your Zebra puzzle mats before installing them. - We recommend installing Zebra puzzle mats directly onto concrete, wood, laminate, or tile subfloor whenever possible.
- If Zebra puzzle mats are installed over carpet, we recommend placing a plastic sheet over the carpet to act as a barrier to protect the carpet from moisture.
- Zebra puzzle mats are intended for indoor use only and should not be installed in areas where temperatures may fluctuate.
- Zebra puzzle mats should be removed from the shipping bag and allowed to adjust to room temperature for a minimum of 24 hours prior to installation.
- Zebra puzzle mats are water resistant, but they should not be saturated with water. The water can seep through the cracks and settle beneath the mats which may cause mold or mildew issues.
- If your Zebra puzzle mats become saturated with water, lift them up, take them apart, and allow them to fully dry before reinstalling them.
- To connect the Zebra puzzle mats, all of the mats must be facing the same direction. Use the corner tab on each mat as a guide.

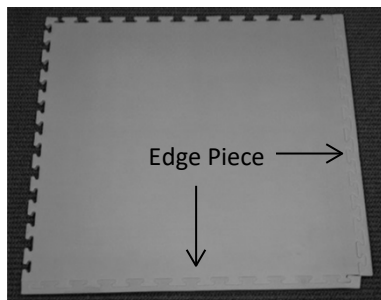

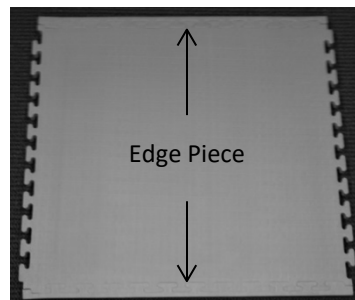
1" Puzzle Mat

Wall to Wall Directions

1. Gather necessary tools: tape measure, utility knife, straight edge, and a rubber mallet.
2. Make sure the floor surface is smooth, even, clean, and dry before starting installation.
3. Attach the edge pieces to the sides of the puzzle mat that will be against the wall. Set the first mat in the corner. Allow a ½" allowance between the edge of the puzzle mats and the wall to allow for expansion of the mats.
4. Continue setting the mats in place. Connect the puzzle mats together by tapping the tabs in place with a rubber mallet.
5. Use a utility knife and straight edge to cut the puzzle mats to size. The tabs can also be cut off to make a straight edge if an edge piece is not used.
6. At the edge of the layout, you may choose to install the Zebra framing kit to keep the mats from shifting. Please refer to the Zebra frame kit instructions.
7. Once your Zebra puzzle mats are completely installed, we recommend cleaning them with Zebra Enviro-care cleaner. Please refer to our care and maintenance instructions.

Area Rug Layout Directions

1. Assemble the puzzle mats into the desired layout. Connect the puzzle mats by tapping the tabs in place with a rubber mallet.
2. Attach the edge pieces or remove the edge tabs with a utility knife and a straight edge.
3. At the edges of the layout, you may choose to install the Zebra framing kit to keep the mats from shifting. Please refer to the Zebra frame kit instructions.
4. Once your Zebra puzzle mats are completely installed, we recommend cleaning them with Zebra Enviro-care cleaner. Please refer to our care and maintenance instructions.

Zebra Frame Kit Instructions

1. Stain or paint the Zebra frame kit prior to installing it. Allow to completely dry.
2. Measure the lengths of trim needed at the edges of the layout and cut the trim as needed with a chop saw or miter box.
3. Set the trim pieces next to the mats and mark where the holes need to be drilled. **CAUTION:** PLEASE CONSULT WITH THE FACILITY MANAGER BEFORE DRILLING INTO THE FLOOR TO CONFIRM THERE ARE NO WATER AND/OR ELECTRIC LINES PRESENT IN THE FLOOR.
4. Using an appropriate bit, drill a hole into the sub-floor approximately 1/2" deeper than the screws.
5. Screw the frame into the sub-floor and place the wooden screw caps over the screws.
