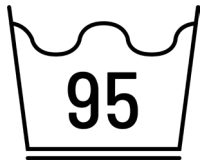




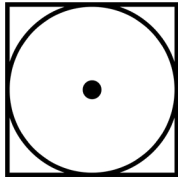
Microfiber Care and Washing Procedures

WASHING



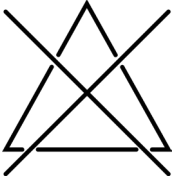
- Maximum Temperature: 95°C (200°F)
- Use alkaline detergent with a pH level under 12.
- Mechanical action normal.
- Spinning normal.
- Rinsing normal.

TUMBLE DRY



- Maximum Temperature: 60°C (140°F)
- Tumble dry at low temperature and remove items from machine promptly.
- Avoid over-drying.

BLEACH



- Do not use chlorine bleach!*
- (Using chlorine bleach will aggressively degrade the pad and backing).*
- May use oxygen bleach with pH value range 4.0 to 11.0.

GENERAL CARE GUIDELINES

- The use of fabric softener is not recommended.
(Fabric softener coats and clogs the microfiber making it less effective)
- Laundry net uses are highly recommended when washing and drying.
- Be careful when machine washing or drying in mixed loads.
(Microfiber products will pick up lint from other fabrics).
- Laundering equipment should be loaded to capacity.
- Avoid over-boil.

* Customers might not need bleach on microfiber because microfiber mops use 95% less water and chemicals than conventional cotton mops. It is more effective cleaning and machine washing.
