









The Dos and Don'ts of Cleaning Your Zebra Mats

Clean and maintain your Smooth and Tatami Zebra Mats using these best practices. This will help you get the most out of your mats, keep them sanitized, and extend their lifespan.

DO	DON'T
 <p>Use Neutral Substances (No Cleaners with Overly Acidic or Basic Properties)</p>	 <p>Use Harsh Chemicals (Cleaners Containing Bleach, Alcohol, Plasticizers, Acid)</p>
 <p>Use the Right Mops and Scrubbers (Microfiber, Cloth, Soft Bristles)</p>	 <p>Use Mops and Scrubbers with Harsh Bristles or Abrasive Surfaces</p>
 <p>Apply Cleaners by Gently Spraying or Misting</p>	 <p>Soak or Submerge Mats or Use Forceful Sprays</p>
 <p>Vacuum, Mop, and Hand Wash Your Mats</p>	 <p>Steam Clean Mats</p>

Zebra Mat Cleaning Schedule

DAILY	<p>Disinfect After Every Class</p> <p>Treat Any Spills/Messes on the Mats</p>
WEEKLY	<p>Vacuum Around Edges of Mat Space</p> <p>Do Detailed Mat Cleaning</p>
MONTHLY	<p>Lift Up Mats and Vacuum Underneath</p> <p>Remove Sweat Buildup with Mineral Deposit Cleaner</p>
YEARLY	<p>Twice a Year: Remove Mats from Space and Vacuum and Sanitize Underneath</p> <p>Take Mats Outside, Lie on Side, Lightly Pressure Wash</p>
